Patrick Roblin received the Maîtrise de Physics degree from the Louis Pasteur University, Strasbourg, France, in 1980, and the D.Sc. degrees in Electrical Engineering from Washington University, St. Louis, MO, in 1984. In 1984, he joined the Department of Electrical Engineering at The Ohio State University, Columbus, OH where he is currently a Professor. His present research interests include the measurement, modeling, design and linearization of non-linear RF devices and circuits such as power-amplifiers and MIMO systems.

He authored and co-authored two textbooks published by Cambridge University Press. He is the founder of the Non-Linear RF research lab at OSU. He has also developed at OSU two educational RF/microwave laboratories and associated curriculum for training both undergraduate and graduate students. He is currently serving as a Distinguished Microwave Lecturer for IEEE-MTT.
